4. How to apply:

- a. Complete the Director's Award Application Form.
- b. Submit an up-to-date summary of all musical/visual artistic/dramatic or acting training together with details of examination results and public performances. A copy of relevant academic qualifications should also be attached.
- c. Submit for an interview:
 - Music Audition: A presentation of three short contrasting styles to backing CD. *
 - Dance Audition: A program of three contrasting works performed with or without backing CD. *
 - Drama Audition: A presentation of two contrasting monologues. *

* Overseas applicants may submit an audition recording/DVD.

 - Visual Arts Portfolio: a portfolio of between three and five items. The portfolio must contain works representative of at least three different styles. Overseas applicants may submit a series of photographs or CD-rom.
- d. Attend an interview with the audition panel at a mutually convenient time as arranged. Other arrangements will be made for overseas applicants.

5. Conditions:

- a. A non-refundable application fee of \$55.00 must accompany the Director’s Award audition.
- b. AIPAH awards the Director’s Award to students who possess outstanding talents, and may be enrolled or intending students of AIPAH.
- c. Current AIPAH students should note the following essential criteria for continuing Director’s Award. An application must be lodged annually and outstanding achievement recorded in one or more of the following:
 - Musical performance
 - The dramatic arts
 - The visual arts
 - Academic excellence
- d. Director’s Award holders will be required to take part in all aspects of AIPAH’s activities including ensemble, performance classes, special concerts, orchestra and on any occasion as deemed necessary. Director’s Award duties may also include clerical or library duties if deemed necessary. Awardees must also have an exemplary record of attendance.
- e. AIPAH may withhold any or all of the award if a sufficient standard is not attained. Director’s Awards may be forfeited if the attendance record is not good in any subject, or if there is a failure in any subject. In this case, students will be liable for the payment of fees from the date of termination of the Director’s Award. The principal may recommend that the Director’s Award be terminated at any time.
- f. All Director’s Award funds are put towards AIPAH fees. No cash awards will be made.
- g. **Refunds:** If a refund is applicable (see Student Contract), the refund is calculated on the balance of fees paid after the Director’s Award grant is deducted.
- h. If the student withdraws from AIPAH and is not entitled to a refund, the Director’s Award grant must be repaid to AIPAH in full. Should any change be made to the student’s enrolment status including but not limited to deferment, discontinuation or cancellation of completion of the student’s HSC (this includes transfer to another institution), the Director’s Award will be forfeited and the student is required to pay the full award amount granted for the period of study already undertaken.
- i. AIPAH reserves the right to make reasonable changes to these terms and conditions at any time and will advise valid students if this occurs, as and when required.
